Bow String	Abrasion cuts or grazes to arm. Facial injury	Participants	M	Instruction in correct technique Long sleeves or arm braces worn by all participants Long hair and baggy clothing tied back Earrings and facial jewellery removed	Y	L
Arrows in ground quivers	Eye injury, cuts, grazes	Participants	M	Participant awareness No running permitted on range	Y	L
Equipment failure	Physical injury, cuts, grazes, bruises	Participants	L	All equipment checked by instructors prior to use Equipment checks carried out on a regular basis	Y	L
